Paper Submission deadline: January 28, 2022

Notification to Authors: March 8, 2022

Prizes will be awarded at the Congress banquet (on June 7, 2022) for top three papers; First (\$1000), Second (\$750) and Third (\$500).

Eligibility:

1. Must be registered as a full-time student at a university
2. Must be the First Author of the paper
3. Must be the Presenting Author at the Congress

Evaluation Criteria:

The evaluation will be based on the quality of (i) the submitted paper and (ii) presentation at the 2022 CSME Congress and will be conducted by a panel of judges.

Paper evaluation will be based on:

- Scientific value and originality of research
- Organization of research
- Appropriateness of research methodology
- Background literature
- Strength of conclusions

Presentation evaluation will be based on:

- Originality
- Purpose
- Methods
- Conclusions
- Presentation visuals
- Answers to questions
